



National Honor Society Summary Sheet 2018 Application

The National Honor Society is a national organization which recognizes those students who excel in academic achievement, leadership and academic integrity, and contribute to their school and community. Members of the honor society at Northport High School uphold the high standards which are the framework for the national organization and provide a variety of school and community services.

Eligibility is open to any sophomore, junior and senior in good academic standing with a minimum of a 93% weighted cumulative average. You must provide evidence of school and community participation as outlined below:

- At least **two** school sponsored extra/co-curricular activities **or** sports each year within the high school. Each activity must be completed through the duration of that activity (i.e. one sports season, one year of a club etc.). Clubs need not be the same each year, but must be completed for that school year. Each activity must have the coach/advisor signature attached to the activity.

AND

- 5 hours community service outside **OR** school sponsored. Each community service must have the description and advisor signature.

Admission of membership is based EQUALLY on scholarship, service, leadership, character and academic integrity.



REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION:

Please read and follow CAREFULLY!

1. Fill out and submit the google form found on our website (www.northportnhs.com) with your personal contact information including email, phone numbers and current grade.
2. Submit each of the service evaluation sheets to the appropriate school or community advisor/coach/director to be filled out and signed. Please remember that a continuing commitment to a few activities is more important than a passing interest in many activities.

**** DO NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- Activities for which you received a salary
- Middle school activities

3. On the attached forms, please list ALL service, sports, clubs, or community activities done on the high school level. Be sure that each entry has an advisor/supevisor/coach's name and signature (including dates of participation and description of involvement).
4. List any special honors, awards, recognition on the sheet provided.
5. You may include any additional pages if needed.
6. Return these completed sheets personally to the **main office** located across from the principal's office at the high school upstairs from reception by 3:30 pm on January 18, 2019. **Your signature will be required at the time you drop off you application so do NOT have others submit it for you.**
7. Incomplete applications and forms without signatures will **AUTOMATICALLY BE CONSIDERED VOID.**
